THE CHAIRMAN: In view of that, is there any necessity for this section at all. Dr. Bard?

DR. BARD: No, not really,

THE CHAIRMAN: Any objection to deleting it? All right, the section will be deleted then.

Section 8.

DR. BARD: Section 8: This is our most controversial recommendation. Has Mr. Miles left? Section The General Assembly shall be a continuous body, meeting in regular annual sessions commencing on the third Wednesday of January of every year and terminating as provided by law. The governor may convene the General Assembly in special session at any time.

I would like to underscore the commentary here: Under the provisions of this section, the General Assembly, and presumably will, fix the termination date for its annual session, whether for 70 days, for 90 days, or for some other period of time. The words, continuous body, are not intended to mean that the General Assembly must
