

1 THE CHAIRMAN: The rules adopted by one Legis-
2 lature are not binding on another. If it is a continuous
3 body, they could be. I think this is the kind of thing
4 the Committee is thinking of.

5 DR. BARD: That is right.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Miles?

7 MR. MILES: Mr. Chairman, just to provoke dis-
8 cussion, I move it is the sense of the Commission that
9 there be a fixed number of days for every regular session
10 of the Legislature, whether that be three or four months,
11 and of course, the governor having the right to call
12 special sessions as he pleases.

13 MR. CASE: I will second this.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Any discussion? Mr. Bond?

15 MR. BOND: I would like to ask Dr. Winslow,
16 what section of Article 3 sets the 70-day session now?

17 DR. WINSLOW: You misunderstood me, the present
18 Constitution sets a 70-day session.

19 MR. BOND: I am asking you whereabouts in
20 the present Constitution?

21 DR. WINSLOW: I am sorry.
