the day it was introduced into the General Assembly, and it is true that this business was sort of used as a smoke screen to kill it, but it was a dead bill, no question about that, and no matter how the press tried to pump it up, it was dead.

Now, I think that the testimony of people who have been before this Commission, who have stated, as somebody here said, that they can do their work if they get down to it, is a valid point, and I have never talked to a legislator in private yet who has said, If we have to do it, we can do it, and I would defer to you, Dale, on this point. You served in the Senate, and so did Stan Hoff, both of you, but I just think that leaving the thing wide open will be bad for the citizens, bad for the State, and bad for our general governmental process.

JUDGE ADKINS: I would like to ask a question and then make a brief comment. Is this continuous concept, does this relate to the fact that a legislature is a continuing body, even after an election?
