not fragment. In other words, you are already restricting the strength that you want to grant to the Legislature if you put this type of restriction on it. Legislative problems should be refaced when they arise and not in spasms. True emergencies should be the only reason for special sessions. Moreover, legislative action should be preceded by intensive study and analysis.

This leads into a healthy development on

the pre-filing, et cetera, but it is also an even greater reason why you need a continuous session or a continuing session, and I know that certain legislative leaders are split on this very point of getting the work out, if you have a limit, and on the others say you are not going to have as good work get out if you do have a limit. I think that you are going to have to regard all the new type of staff, work; being able to adjourn, come back as a result of the staff work, et cetera. It is a new era and we have to have a Legislature able to cope with it and not have strings tied such as a certain specified number of days.
