

1 is my motion. I made it my business to talk to a great
2 many members of the Legislature and what Mr. Case says
3 is absolutely correct. I have yet to talk to one private-
4 ly who does not think there should be a terminal date
5 fixed. I have heard differences of opinion as to whether
6 it be 70 days, 90 days or four months. I am strongly of
7 the opinion that there ought to be some terminal date of
8 the regular session.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: The question arises on the motion
10 to amend this session to provide a maximum limit on the
11 length of the sessions of the Legislature. I will submit
12 as a separate question the question of whether the Legis-
13 lature should be a continuing body.

14 DR. BARD: I have a question in regard to the
15 point: Does the motion embody a specific maximum date?

16 THE CHAIRMAN: No. Does not. That will be
17 separately determined if the motion passes. Are you
18 ready for the question? A vote Aye is a vote that there
19 shall be a limitation on the length of the session. It
20 does not fix a limitation and it doesn't fix the number
21 of days. All in favor, please signify by raising hands.
