this proceeding. Mr. Banister has a notation of the seat occupied by every member labeled with his name. So the first requirement to aid him is please continue to occupy throughout the meeting the same seat that you are now occupying.

Secondly, please wait until the Chair recognizes you before speaking. This will give me an opportunity to call your name and save Mr. Banister the necessity of looking down on the sheet to identify each person.

Thirdly, I don't want to impose any rigid requirements but I would suggest that insofar as possible, please in speaking on any matter before the Commission at any time during the four sessions say everything you have to say on the point at one time and do not come back into the discussion again until other members of the Commission who may want to speakhave spoken If you have already made your point, let it rest and don't come back for further emphasis. I say that because if we get into too long debates on any particular matter, we will simply never finish.
