MR. GENTRY: Section 7 is a revamp although

it holds what we felt was the wishes of the Commission 3 at the Easton meeting to allow to the subdivisions authority over local elections. But we wanted to retain 5 all the qualifications of Section 1 with the two 6 exceptions. With the proviso that they could establish 7 a longer residence period up to but not exceeding one 8 year and that they could also extend the voting right 9 to nonresidents who own taxable real estate in that locale. 10 It was felt with the exception of those two instances-11: all the voting requirements as set out for state and 12 Federal elections as mentioned in Section 1 should 13
