

1 particularly those sections distributing the so-called  
2 Sherbow funds, that funds go to counties which are  
3 called political subdivisions.

4 In other words, what I am saying is that the  
5 term political subdivisions can mean a county, it can  
6 mean a city, it can mean a taxing district or it can  
7 mean any other municipal area.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: I think that's what the  
9 Committee intends here.

10 MR. CASE: I am wondering whether or not you  
11 really mean that a political subdivision such as let's  
12 say, Prince Georges County would be able to establish  
13 a one-year qualification for a local election and yet  
14 as I understand it, Section 1 provides for some shorter  
15 period.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Six months.

17 MR. CASE: If you have, as we do now, as I  
18 expect it will continue to be, general and local elections  
19 held at the same time on the same voting machines, same  
20 day, I think it is going to cause an intolerable situation  
21 to have people coming in presenting themselves to vote
