particularly those sections distributing the so-called Sherbow funds, that funds go to counties which are called political subdivisions

In other words, what I am saying is that the term political subdivisions can mean a county, it can mean a city, it can mean a taxing district or it can mean any other municipal area.

THE CHAIRMAN: I think that's what the Committee intends here.

MR. CASE: I am wondering whether or not you really mean that a political subdivision such as, let say, Prince Georges County would be able to establish a one-year qualification for a local election and yet as I understand it, Section 1 provides for some shorter period.

THE CHAIRMAN: Six months.

If you have, as we do now, as I MR. CASE: expect it will continue to be, general and local elections held at the same time on the same voting machines, same day, I think it is going to cause an intolerable situation to have people coming in presenting themselves to vote
