2 men or whatever you call them. It was my recollection  
3 at the Easton meeting, I could be wrong, that what the  
4 Commission was thinking about here were elections in the  
5 towns. I think the illustration was some of the resort  
6 cities like Ocean City and that kind of thing. I  
7 venture to say if you make a difference, if you provide  
8 for a different system of qualifications for a county-  
9 wide election than for state election, you will have  
10 utter chaos.

21 going to recommend provisions with regard to home rule,
