was going to be taxed for that system. This is not true in the county as a whole. The reasoning is totally different when you apply it to the county. Therefore, I submit a different result should follow.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Scanlan.

MR. SCANLAN: I must confess I certainly share Mr. Case's recollection. The whole discussion of this article before us was in terms of the municipalities. I wouldn't have voted for it in this form because it seems to me in this form it goes a long way to impair the liberalizing and unifying impact of Section 1. In addition to the confusion on the machine and how you would set it up, which I can mainly see it might have also an adverse impact in reducing the number of those who would take the time and trouble to cast a vote in the state election. They would find they are not eligible in the county and would say to heck with it.

I would move that the phrase political subdivision be changed to municipality.

PROFESSOR ASPER: Is that a term of art?

MR. SCANLAN: Municipal corporation.
