2 estate.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Gentry, do you want to
4 comment?

5 MR. GENTRY: I don't think that was given
6 special consideration.

7 PROFESSOR: ASPER: It was, based on my
8 recollection of the discussion, it was all, the only
9 things actually discussed were Ocean City and Bel Air
10 on real property, people who owned homes, summer homes,
11 this sort of thing.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Was it that or was it the
13 intent to permit the municipality to extend the right
14 to vote to taxpayers?

15 PROFESSOR ASPER: I understood that it was
16 owners of real property subject, as Mr. Case suggested,
17 to sewerage assessments and that sort of thing.

18 MR. MARTINEAU: I believe the phrase, from
19 the abbreviated version of the minutes I have, I
20 believe Mr. Miles used it, he said property owner, but did
21 not designate real or personal property.
