

1 All those in favor signify by saying aye, contrary, no.  
2 The ayes have it, so ordered.

3 MR. GENTRY: Moving down to those sections  
4 of the article relating to referendum, in Section 8,  
5 which describes the referendum and filing of it,  
6 signatures, et cetera, we have changed. The fact that  
7 emergency law should now read three-fifths vote because  
8 we might not have an emergency law definition picked up  
9 elsewhere.

10 We took out the reference to file with the  
11 Secretary of State, left that blank.

12 That is the only change. Other than that  
13 Section 8 reads as submitted at Easton. In other  
14 words, there has been no change of substance but just  
15 changed words to mean hopefully the same thing. Three-  
16 fifths vote of all members of each house be equated with  
17 an emergency law.

18 PROFESSOR ASPER: It is more comprehensive  
19 than an emergency law. As I understand it, it was the  
20 wish of the Commission that this apply to any law passed  
21 by a three-fifths majority of members of both houses
