That is that you might have members of the Legislature who would be in fivor of a bill and wanted to be recorded as voting for it but not be in favor of withdrawing that bill from referendum.

In other words, if you had a provision in this section that said, for instance, provided that any law designated as nonreferable and passed by threefifths vote, et cetera, a member of the Legislature who would be for the bill might vote against it because he would not want to withdraw it from the referendum and that in that situation you would pose a dilemma for such a member with this language.

PROFESSOR ASPER: May I point out that this provision does not say that these bills are not referable but merely says they go into effect immediately, shall not be suspended by action of the referendum petition.

What is to be not subject to referendum is in Section 10.

MR. CLAGETT: There would be no reason why the bill itself could not provide for a referendum
