possibility of filing a petition where the bill goes into effect immediately.

MR. HAILE: If we insert after the word

General Assembly on top of Page 6, the phrase may
expressly provide it, those four words, then you would
have a proviso provided that any law passed by a threefifths vote of all members of each House of the General
Assembly may expressly provide that it shall take
effect notwithstanding a referendum.

In the bill before it is enacted, it could have a clause which says by vote of three-fifths it is declared that this bill will take effect notwithstanding a referendum petition. If it passes by three-fifths vote that is law.

THE CHAIRMAN: That is not Mr. Martineau's point. His point is that if the Legislature passes a bill by any vote and says it is effective tomorrow, you have cut off the right to referendum because there isn't time to file a petition before the effective date.

MR. MARTINEAU: Particularly under the interpretation you can't gather signatures on a petition until
