if a bill is to become effective immediately the 60-day procedure specified in Section 9 would be applicable to such a bill.

THE CHAIRMAN: That is correct. And there are several other suggestions as to phraseology.

DR. WINSLOW: May I raise a question of location on this. Maybe this is for the Committee on Style. It would seem to me the whole business of the referendum belongs with the Legislative Department, not with elective franchise. This is part of the law-making process just as the Governor's veto is part of it. This referendum belongs in the article dealing with the Legislative Department. Has that been decided otherwise by the Commission?

THE CHAIRMAN: Decided otherwise by the staff, you might say, in the original allocation. You can allocate it to this Committee on the theory that it is the act of the electorate that you are dealing with and hence belongs in the article on elective franchise. I think as a practical matter in view of the close relationship between this article and that of the
