is deleted, I will entertain a motion if anybody cares to so move of substituting a different restriction or limitation. Any further discussion? Then the question arises on the recommendation of the Committee that the bracketed language in Section 9 be deleted. Are you ready for the question? All those in favor, signify by show of hands. Opposed. Motion carried 16 to 2.

I want to recognize anybody who desires to make a motion to substitute any other restrictive language in place of that deleted. Mr. Bond.

MR. BOND: I would propose, Mr. Chairman, that the language in the existing constitution which states that of whom not more than half shall be residents of Baltimore City or any one county be inserted in this section 9.

DR. BARD: Second.

MR. BOND: I will speak briefly to that if
I may. I sympathize with Mrs. Freedlander and Mr. Gentry
but at the same time the Commission did vote if we were
to have a referendum, I don't think we should drop all
restrictive language and I think that we presently
