MR. CASE: I raise the question. I haven't any deep-seated feeling about it. I think it is something you might think about.

DR. BURDETTE: I think we ought to face this. If we say not more than 30, we might be saying we have to have the petition signatures planned by the securers over five or six jurisdictions to be sure that they don't get thrown out on the 30 per cent rule. That would cut more broad than anything we have talked about this-afternoon:

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment? I would like to make one comment then, if I may. Recommendations of other committees: if adopted by the Commission will endeavor to provide that the Legislature shall not pass local legislation and that all legislation passed by the Legislature will be general legislation.
