

1 per cent by your language not more than half. Or very
2 close to 30.

3 MR. CASE: I raise the question. I haven't
4 any deep-seated feeling about it. I think it is
5 something you might think about.

6 DR. BURDETTE: I think we ought to face this.
7 If we say not more than 30, we might be saying we have
8 to have the petition signatures planned by the securers
9 over five or six jurisdictions to be sure that they
10 don't get thrown out on the 30 per cent rule. That would
11 cut more broad than anything we have talked about
12 this afternoon.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment? I would
14 like to make one comment then, if I may. Recommendations
15 of other committees if adopted by the Commission will
16 endeavor to provide that the Legislature shall not pass
17 local legislation and that all legislation passed by
18 the Legislature will be general legislation.

19 I think it is safe to say that at some point
20 in the future there is, however, going to be a bill or
21 bills introduced and passed that will be under the guise
