

1 MR. SCANLAN: No, I just felt that some of
2 the grossest abuses in my opinion of the referendum
3 occurred in connection with the Congressional districting.
4 Of course, I would hope that in cutting down on the
5 right to referendum that that particular area would
6 also be included in the proposed section 10.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Gentry.

8 MR. GENTRY: Only that the Committee did
9 not exclude redistricting. It just didn't consider it.
10 It was acting on what was our directive at Easton which
11 was to pick up as an exclusion reapportionment.

12 PROFESSOR ASPER: Nothing further.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment or
14 discussion?

15 DR. BARD: I would like to say I favor this
16 proposal not because of the experiences which Mr. Scanlan
17 has had but because the Legislative Department has now,
18 its proposal is now set forth something that is a little
19 more affirmative and protective in terms of these
20 kinds of experiences.
