suggestion last time that this be done to make it absolutely clear from now on.

THE CHAIRMAN: That is right, my only point was we didn't use or discuss the language, no law imposing a tax. I wanted to flag it for the Commission.

MR. CASE: That is right. There wasn't any language proposed. But I have another comment as long as we are making comments about this.

THE CHAIRMAN: This section?

MR. CASE: Yes.

THE CHAIRMAN: Go ahead.

MR. CASE: The present Constitution, in dealing with the fact that the act making appropriation, as distinguished from the tax is not referable, limits though that nonreferable part to an appropriation which does not exceed the next previous appropriation for the same purpose.

That is not in here. I have been turning over in my mind just how I feel about it. I am not sure. It might be something I would like to ask, if I may, whether the Committee consciously left this out,
