appropriate regulations for all human conduct and relations within the affected society for the next 100 years. A well-conceived constitution designs and creates the machinery of self-government through which the actual process of regulation must be carried on. Taken in this setting, a Declartion of Rights is an enumeration of those rights which the people, as individuals, which to hold beyond the power of government. It should not be a prologue to the constitution, nor a statement of what the agencies of government can do, nor a broadly stated directive as to how a government

With that I would like to then point up that we recommend, the Committee recommends that the Declaracif Rights not be separated from the body of the Constitution but rather that it be considered Article 1.

should do what it is given power to do.

We move these various sections which start with Section 1 and we have a reason and meaning behind each of these as well as in the second part we take up the various articles of our present declaration and why they are included or why they are eliminated,
