2 this, I will move that Section 6 be not deleted from  
3 our Constitution.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: I don't think the adoption of  
5 Section 1 necessarily deletes Section 6.

6 MR. CASE: I raised that question before I  
7 made this statement. I came prepared to make a statement  
8 along this line. I didn't know when the appropriate  
9 time would be.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: This is the appropriate time.  
11 I merely point out to you I don't think adoption  
12 of Section 1 necessarily carries with it each of the  
13 recommendations following it as to the deletion of  
14 other sections. You may want to make a motion specifi-  
15 cally with respect to Section 1 also, I don't know.

16 MR. SCANLAN: Could I ask Dick a question.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Let me clarify the motion.  
18 You may want to make a motion with respect to Section  
19 1 also. I will entertain your motion that Section 6  
20 not be deleted standing alone irrespective of Section  
21 1.
