Mr. Goldsborough, of Talbot, from the Committee on Finance, reported favorably the following:

A bill, entitled, An act to amend the 4th Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, by adding thereto the following sections, authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to increase the public debt of said city, and repealing section 871 of said Article;
