

Mr. Lynch, from the Committee on Corporations, reported favorably, with amendment, the following House bill:

A bill, entitled, An act to to incorporate the Baltimore, Catonsville and Ellicott's Mills Passenger Rail Company.

AMENDMENT:

First section, fifth line, insert: "and not exceeding in length, parallel with said road, one hundred yards, at and from Gwynn's Falls, on said road."

Said amendment was concurred in.

The bill was then read the second time, and, by special order, the third time, and passed by yeas and nays as follows:

A bill, entitled, An act to change the place of holding elections in the Sixth District of Prince George's county;
