A bill, entitled, An act for the relief of Harriet Porter and Miranda Porter, of Carroll county;

A bill, entitled, An act to provide for the payment of a sum of money to Captain Gabriel Becklie, of the United Guards of Frederick county, for services rendered under order of the Governor,

Was taken up, and recommitted to the Committee on Militia.

On motion of Mr. Franklin,

Ordered, That the Committee on Claims allow Thomas A. Mitchell, Sergeant-at-Arms, two dollars per day for his services in taking care of the desks of Senators, and in discharging other duties during the recesses of the Legislature, in accordance with an order of the Senate, adopted the 11th day of May, 1861.
