

## BANKS—

To report a bill to authorize the Courts of Equity of this State to direct the deposit of trust funds in the banks of this State, 298, 301, 325.

BALTIMORE CITY—Mayor and City Council, empowering them to raise and appropriate money for defence of city, 13, 14.

A bill ratifying an ordinance appropriating \$500,000 for defence of the city, 13, 14.

To relieve the Mayor and Board of Police, and all persons acting under them, in their efforts to maintain the peace after the 19th of April, 1861, 75, 87, 88.

Giving authority to the Mayor and City Council to issue certificates of debt to an amount not exceeding \$500,000, 94, 110, 111.

Memorial of John Sullivan & Sons, and forty other merchants, for the repeal of the law to sell the tobacco warehouses, 142.
