CECIL COUNTY—Twenty-four citizens against the passage of the safety law, 67.

By telegraphic despatch of over forty-two citizens, protesting against the safety bill, 73.

Fifty-four citizens of Port Deposit against a bill appointing a Committee of Safety, 83.

Thirty-five citizens, against sending Commissioners to other States—against the call of a Convention—praying the adjournment of the Legislature *sine die*, &c., &c.; also, the remonstrance of ninety-nine other citizens; also, the memorial of sundry other citizens of Cecil county, 120.
