

MESSAGE—

Proposing the appointment of a Joint Committee to consider the propriety of appointing committees to wait on President of United States, President of Southern Confederacy, and the Governor of Virginia, with a view of averting civil war, &c., 22.

Concurring in the appointment of Messrs. Scott, McLane and Ross, 27, 28, 29.

To the Governor, inquiring whether he authorized the burning of the bridges on the Northern Central, Baltimore, Wilmington and Philadelphia Rail Roads, 33, 34.

Proposing an adjournment to May 7th, 34.

From Executive, referred to Committee on Federal Relations, 64.

Proposing a Joint Committee to wait on the Governor, inform him that the Legislature is in session, and are ready to receive any communication, 139.
