Mr. Dashiell offered the following

AMENDMENT:

Amend by striking out all after the word telegram in the last paragraph.

Mr. McKaig offered as a substitute, the following:

Ordered, That in the matter of the Telegraphic dispatch from Cecil co., presented by the Senator from Frederick, in the opinion of the Senate, that Senator acted properly and in strict accordance with his duty as a Senator and a member of this body, and that the concluding paragraph of the report of the Committee to whom that Telegram was referred, be not concurred in, and that the balance of the report be concurred in.

The question was then taken upon the adoption of the report, and concurred in.
