Also, the bill entitled, an act to enable A. Lingan Jarrett, Comptroller of Maryland, to enter into bond and qualify;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to make valid the qualification of Tench Tilghman, as Major General of the second division of Maryland militia;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to amend article LXXXVIII of the Code of Public General Laws, by repealing the 46th and 47th sections thereof, and substituting the following therefor, in relation to sheriffs;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to amend article XXXVIII of the Code of General Laws, by repealing the second section thereof and substituting therefor the following, in relation to fees of officers;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to amend article LVII of Public General Laws, by repealing the first section thereof and re-enacting the same with an attestation touching the limitation of certain actions for wrongs affecting the personal rights of the citizen;
