Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Librarian be and his hereby authorized and directed, to prepare a new catalogue of the books, public documents and other property of the State, now in the library, under the direction of the committee herein after mentioned, and to ascertain as far as possible what steps are necessary to secure their restoration, the number of books, public documents and other property of the State that has been lost out of the library, and by whom lost, and what book and public documents are now necessary to supply broken sets of reports, and other books and public documents.

Resolved, That such catalogue when so made shall be conclusive evidence against said Librarian of the possession of all
