Communication presented from the Mayor of Baltimore in reference to the action of the Governor of Maryland, in connexion with the Mayor and Board of Police of Baltimore, to protect the peace of city on and after the 19th of April, 1861, and 2,000 ordered to be printed for the use of the House, 122.

Resolution offered that the Delegates lately elected from Baltimore city, and now members of this body, were elected in plain violation of the 29th section of the Constitution and the 49th section of the Code of Public Laws, and are therefore not legally entitled to seats upon this floor, referred to a special committee, 125; report made and resolution presented, that said delegates are entitled to seats upon the floor of this House, and to all the rights, privileges and immunities of members of said House, rules suspended and resolution passed, 133, 134, 135; unfavorable report on the original resolution, 136.

Leave granted special committee to report a bill to amend the 412th section of article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the inspection of hay and straw in, 169; bill reported and read a first time, 187; read the second and, by special order, the third time, and passed, 198; returned from Senate passed, 251.
