Moore of Worcester county, were seized by General Butler, with his knowledge and consent, and and if he has taken any action to restore them, &c., adopted, 268; message of, in response thereto; returned to the Executive, 274.

Order, that the Governor be requested to open negotiations with the authorities in Washington, to procure the return of runaway slaves in military camps, &c., adopted, 269.

Resolutions requesting the Governor to transmit to Governor of Virginia, the resolutions passed by the Legislature, that Maryland will rely upon the honor of Virginia to make full recompense for all property of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Co., destroyed by the Military forces of Virginia, adopted, 276.

Resolution from committee on Federal Relations requesting the Governor so return to the Armories of the State the arms which have been removed from the Armories, and deposited in Fort McHenry, or placed in the hands of ununiformed companies or assosiations, and that he return to all regularly organized and uniformed volunteer companies the arms re-claimed from them by his order, passed, 320.
