The question then recurring upon the following "amendment proposed,"

Section third, line sixteen, strike out the words "the sum of three," and insert "more than one;"

It was adopted.

The next "amendment proposed,"

Section six, strike out all after the word "exist" in line five to the end of the section;

Was adopted.

The bill with amendments was then read the second time, Mr. Maxwell moved to suspend the rules, to give the bill a third reading.
