The Secretary of the Senate returned the following bill :

A bill entitled, an act to amend the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws, by adding thereto the following section, vesting in the Board of Police of the city of Baltimore all the authority in said city now vested in a single magistrate and constable, under the provisions of the 66th article of the Code of Public General Laws, in regard to free negroes and mulattoes ;
