## XLV.

The following Standing Committees, each to consist of seven members, (except the Committees on Ways and Means, Judiciary and Corporations, which shall consist of nine members each,) shall be appointed by the Speaker, at the commencement of the session, viz:

- 1. A Committee on Elections.
- 2. A Committee on Ways and Means.
- 3. A Committee on Claims.
- 4. A Committee on Judiciary.
- 5. A Committee on Pensions.
- 6. A Committee on Internal Improvements.
- 7. A Committee on Education.
- 8. A Committee on Militia.
- 9. A Committee on Agriculture.
- 10. A Committee on Corporations.
- 11. A Committee on Inspections.
- 12. A Committee on Colored Population.
- 13. A Committee on Lotteries.
- 14. A Committee on the Library.
- 15. A Committee on Printing.
- 16. A Committee on Insolvency.
- 17. A Committee on Engrossed Bills and Resolutions.
- 18. A Committee on Expiring Laws.
- 19. A Committee on Federal Relations.
- 20. A Committee on Currency.
- 21. A Committee on the Contingent Fund, placed at the disposal of the Executive.
  - 22. A Committee on Roads and Highways.

## XLVI.

All Bills reported to this House by a Committee, of a general character, shall be printed in Bill form; but Bills of a local character shall not be printed, unless ordered by a special vote of the House.
