Be it therefore Eracted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of her Majesty's Governous Council and Assembly of this Province and the shuthority of the fame, that unless the said such and Clark do within twenty Days after the End of this presents Sossion of A Temply surrender himself to his Excellency the Governous, or to any one of her Majesty's honourable Council in order to be tryed for his Treason aforesaid, that then the said such and Clark by Force and Vertue of this Ast shall be Outlawed, and thall forseit his Gonds and Chattels Lands and Tenements as an Outlawed Person, any want of Process or any other legal Proceedings in any wise notwiths and no.
