IMPROVEMENTS FURNISHED FOR OR IN CONNECTION WITH ANY SUCH PROJECTS.

A HOUSING AUTHORITY MAY EXERCISE ANY OR ALL OF IT POWERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF COOPERATING WITH, OR ACTING AS AGENT FOR, THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IN THE <u>DEVELOPMENT OR</u> ADMINISTRATION OF PROJECTS BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO ASSURE THE AVAILABILITY OF SAFE AND SANITARY DWELLINGS FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL AND MAY UNDERTAKE THE <u>DEVELOPMENT OR</u> ADMINISTRATION OF ANY SUCH PROJECT FOR THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

ANY STATE PUBLIC BODY, AS DEFINED IN THIS ARTICLE, SHALL HAVE THE SAME RIGHTS AND POWERS TO COOPERATE WITH HOUSING AUTHORITIES WITH RESPECT TO THE <u>DEVELOPMENT</u> OR ADMINISTRATION OF PROJECTS TO ASSURE THE AVAILABILITY OF SAFE AND SANITARY DWELLINGS FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL THAT SUCH STATE PUBLIC BODY HAS PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING THE <u>DEVELOPMENT</u> OR ADMINISTRATION OF HOUSING PROJECTS FOR PERSONS OF ELIGIBLE INCOME.

BONDS OR OTHER OBLIGATIONS ISSUED BY A HOUSING AUTHORITY FOR A PROJECT DEVELOPED OR ADMINISTERED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE LEGAL INVESTMENTS TO THE SAME EXTENT AND FOR THE SAME PERSONS, INSTITUTIONS, ASSOCIATIONS, CORPORATIONS, BODIES, AND OFFICERS AS BONDS OR OTHER OBLIGATIONS ISSUED PURSUANT TO ANY OTHER SECTION OF THIS ARTICLE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A HOUSING PROJECT FOR PERSONS OF ELIGIBLE INCOME.

THIS SUBTITLE SHALL CONSTITUTE AN INDEPENDENT AUTHORIZATION FOR A HOUSING AUTHORITY TO UNDERTAKE THE DEVELOPMENT OR ADMINISTRATION OF PROJECTS TO ASSURE THE AVAILABILITY OF SAFE AND SANITARY DWELLINGS FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL AS PROVIDED IN THIS ARTICLE AND FOR A HOUSING AUTHORITY TO COOPERATE WITH, OR ACT AS AGENT FOR, THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IN THE DEVELOPMENT OR ADMINISTRATION OF SIMILAR PROJECTS BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT. IN ACTING UNDER THIS AUTHORIZATION, A HOUSING AUTHORITY MAY NOT BE SUBJECT TO ANY LIMITATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, OR REQUIREMENTS OF OTHER LAWS (EXCEPT THOSE RELATING TO LAND ACQUISITION) PRESCRIBING THE PROCEDURE OR ACTION TO BE TAKEN IN THE
