AN ACT concerning

Queen Anne's County - Board of License Commissioners

FOR the purpose of providing that in Queen Anne's County the finding of probation ~~without a verdict~~ before judgment for certain alleged violations of an alcoholic beverages licensee or employee of the licensee is not a bar to a proceeding brought by the Board of License Commissioners; and generally relating to the Queen Anne's County Board of License Commissioners and alleged sales violations of a licensee or employee of a licensee.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
