- 1. May not have served as an officer or director of or attorney for a savings and loan association or related entity during the 3 years immediately before appointment; and
- 2. May not be members of the immediate family of any director or officer or any attorney for a savings and loan association or related entity.
- (3) With the approval of the Governor, the Secretary shall designate one of the members of the Board of Commissioners as its chairman.
- (b) Each member of the Board of Commissioners shall have been a resident and registered voter of this State immediately before appointment.
- (c) Before taking office, each appointee to the Board of Commissioners shall take the oath required by Article I, § 9 of the State Constitution.
 - (d) (1) The term of a member is 4 years and begins on June 1.
- (2) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Board on July 1, 1986.
- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor qualifies and is appointed.
- (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of that term and until a successor qualifies and is appointed.
 - (e) A member of the Board:
- (1) (i) Is entitled to receive \$100 for each day or part of a day that the member performs duties on the Board; but
 - (ii) May not receive more than \$1,000 compensation in any year; and
- (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations as provided in the State budget.]

 - (a) The function of the Board of Commissioners is advisory.
- (b) The Board of Commissioners shall give the Division Director sound and impartial advice on:
 - (1) The approval or disapproval of applications by an association;
- (2) How to protect the interests of the general public and of depositors and stockholders in associations; and
- (3) Any proposed law, regulation, or other matter concerning the business of savings and loan associations in this State.
