(3) AN INDIVIDUAL, GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY, OR THIRD-PARTY PAYOR MAY NOT EXECUTE ON A JUDGMENT ~~INDEXED AND RECORDED~~ RECORDED AND INDEXED UNDER THIS SECTION UNTIL THE TIME PERIOD HAS EXPIRED IN WHICH A DEFENDANT MAY FILE ANY OF THE ACTIONS LISTED UNDER ~~PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SECTION~~ ITEMS (1)(II) THROUGH (VI) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~July 1, 1990~~, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter ~~\_\_\_-(H.B. \_\_\_)-~~ (H.B. 1370)(01r3047) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1990, and if Chapter ~~\_\_\_~~ does not become effective, this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted, subject to the contingency described in Section 2 of this Act.

CHAPTER 387

(House Bill 1377)

AN ACT concerning

**State Police and Natural Resources Police – Court Duty**
