- (F) "WHOLLY OWNED" MAY MEAN INCLUDES LEASED PROPERTY, IF THE:
- (1) (I) LEASE WILL BE FOR A MINIMUM TERM OF 30 YEARS FOLLOWING PROJECT COMPLETION; OR
- (II) LEASE AGREEMENT EXTENDS THE RIGHT OF PURCHASE TO THE LESEE; AND
- (2) LESSOR CONSENTS TO THE RECORDING, IN THE LAND RECORDS OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION IN WHICH THE FACILITY IS LOCATED, OF A NOTICE OF THE STATE'S RIGHT OF RECOVERY IN THE LAND RECORDS OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION IN WHICH THE FACILITY IS LOCATED; AND
- (3) LEASE AGREEMENT EXTENDS THE RIGHT OF PURCHASE TO THE LESSEE AS PROVIDED UNDER § 4-106 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (A) ANY COUNTY, MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, FOR-PROFIT, OR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SPONSORING A PROJECT INVOLVING THE PLANNING, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, CONVERSION, ACQUISITION, RENOVATION, AND EQUIPPING OF A FACILITY IN THE STATE MAY APPLY TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR A STATE GRANT TO BE APPLIED TOWARD THE COST OF THAT PROJECT.
- (B) THE APPLICATION SHALL BE DIRECTED TO THE SECRETARY. ON THE APPROVAL OF A PROJECT AND THE PROJECT PLANS BY THE DEPARTMENT, THE SECRETARY SHALL PROMPTLY REPORT THE APPLICATION TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, TOGETHER WITH THE SECRETARY'S RECOMMENDATION THAT THE BOARD MAKE FUNDS AVAILABLE AS PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE.

- (A) BEFORE THE DEPARTMENT APPROVES ANY PROJECT, THE APPLICANT SHALL FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT:
- (1) A STATEMENT LISTING THE PERSONNEL EMPLOYED OR TO BE EMPLOYED AT THE FACILITY AND SHOWING ALL REMUNERATION AND PREREQUISITE FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND ALL OTHER EXPENSES PAID OR TO BE PAID TO THESE PERSONNEL, AS WELL AS ALL OTHER EXPENSES INCURRED OR TO BE INCURRED IN OPERATING THE FACILITY; AND
- (2) THE SCHEDULE OF RATES CHARGED OR TO BE CHARGED FOR SERVICES RENDERED.
