CHAPTER 391

(House Bill 1394)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County – Economic Development Commission – Terms

FOR the purpose of altering the length of the terms of the members of the Economic Development Commission of Frederick County; providing for the applicability of this Act; and generally relating to the Economic Development Commission of Frederick County.

Article 11 – Public Local Laws of Maryland

(1979 Edition and October, 1989 Supplement, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 11 – Frederick County

2-2-67.

An ordinance or resolution creating an economic development commission shall include the following provisions:

(3) a. That each member serves for a term of [three (3)] 5 years. The terms of the members shall be staggered, as required by the terms of the members serving on July 1, 1985;

b. That they shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for necessary travel and other expenses incurred in the performance of their duties;

c. That the commission shall select from its own membership a chairman, vice chairman, and a secretary-treasurer, who may not be the same person, to serve a term of 1 year and be eligible for reelection; that a person may not hold the position of chairman for more than 3 consecutive terms;

d. That upon the death, disability, resignation, or removal of any
