OBTAINING A WATER SUPPLY, INCLUDING WELLS CONSTRUCTED FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING A HEAT PUMP.

- [(g)] (K) (1) "Well system equipment" means any equipment that is necessary to draw or purify water from a well.
- (2) "Well system equipment" includes any casing, grout, screen, water tank, water pump, or water conditioning equipment.

- (a) [Except for the fees specifically set by this title, the]—THE Board may set reasonable fees for the issuance and renewal of licenses and its other services. ]
- (1) THE BOARD SHALL SET REASONABLE FEES NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT ITS RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS TITLE.
- (2) THE BOARD MAY SET FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES ACCORDING TO CLASS OF LICENSE.
- (b) The Board shall pay any fee collected under this title into the General Fund of the State.

To apply for a license, an applicant shall:

- (1) Submit an application to the Board on the form that the Board requires; and
- (2) Pay to the Board an application fee [of \$10] SET BY THE BOARD. 13-306.
- (b) (1) In accordance with its rules and regulations, the Board [may issue different classes of licenses to practice well drilling] SHALL ISSUE WELL DRILLER LICENSES AND RESTRICTED LICENSES.
- [(2) The Board shall include on each license that it issues a designation of the class of license.]
- (2) (I) THERE ARE 3 CATEGORIES OF WELL DRILLER LICENSES:
  - 1. WELL DRILLER GENERAL;
  - 2. WELL DRILLER GEOTECHNICAL; AND

- 3. WELL DRILLER WATER SUPPLY.
- (II) A WELL DRILLER LICENSE MAY BE LIMITED TO THE DRILLING OF WELLS FOR PARTICULAR PURPOSES.
