

OBTAINING A WATER SUPPLY, INCLUDING WELLS CONSTRUCTED FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING A HEAT PUMP.

[(g)] (K) (1) "Well system equipment" means any equipment that is necessary to draw or purify water from a well.

(2) "Well system equipment" includes any casing, grout, screen, water tank, water pump, or water conditioning equipment.

(a) [Except for the fees specifically set by this title, the] ~~THE~~ Board may set reasonable fees for the issuance and renewal of licenses and its other services. ]

(1) THE BOARD SHALL SET REASONABLE FEES NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT ITS RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS TITLE.

(2) THE BOARD MAY SET FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES ACCORDING TO CLASS OF LICENSE.

(b) The Board shall pay any fee collected under this title into the General Fund of the State.

To apply for a license, an applicant shall:

(1) Submit an application to the Board on the form that the Board requires; and

(2) Pay to the Board an application fee [of \$10] SET BY THE BOARD.

13-306.

(b) (1) In accordance with its rules and regulations, the Board [may issue different classes of licenses to practice well drilling] SHALL ISSUE WELL DRILLER LICENSES AND RESTRICTED LICENSES.

[(2) The Board shall include on each license that it issues a designation of the class of license.]

(2) (I) THERE ARE 3 CATEGORIES OF WELL DRILLER LICENSES:

1. WELL DRILLER GENERAL;
2. WELL DRILLER - GEOTECHNICAL; AND
3. WELL DRILLER - WATER SUPPLY.

(II) A WELL DRILLER LICENSE MAY BE LIMITED TO THE DRILLING OF WELLS FOR PARTICULAR PURPOSES.
