- (7) a representative from each of the following:
 - (i) a private day care center;
 - (ii) a nursery school;
 - (iii) a Head Start program;
 - (iv) a family day care provider;
 - (v) the Infant and Toddler Program;
 - (vi) a public school teacher certificated in early childhood education;
- (vii) a public school administrator working in early childhood education;
 - (viii) the business community;
 - (ix) local government;
 - (x) the State Child Care Resource Center;
- (xi) a community college faculty member involved in the training of child care workers;
- (x) (xii) a 4 year college or university faculty member working in early childhood education; and
 - (xii) (xiii) a group that advocates for day care services.
 - SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
- (D) (1) the <u>The Governor shall</u> designate the Chairman of the Interagency Advisory Committee for Early Childhood Development and Education;
- (2) the <u>The Interagency Advisory Committee for Early Childhood</u> Development and Education <u>shall</u> report its findings and recommendations to the Governor by June 30 each year; and .
- (3) the <u>The staff for the Committee shall</u> be provided by the Maryland State Department of Education.
- SECTION 5 2 .- AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
