THERE IS AN INTERAGENCY ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR EARLY
CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT AND EDUCATION IN THE STATE DEPARTMENT
OF EDUCATION.

24-302.

(A) THE INTERAGENCY ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR EARLY
CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT AND EDUCATION IS COMPOSED OF:

(1) A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY
THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE, AND A MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF
MARYLAND, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;

(2) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION,
APPOINTED BY THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS;

(3) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH,
AND FAMILIES APPOINTED BY THE SPECIAL SECRETARY FOR CHILDREN,
YOUTH, AND FAMILIES;

(4) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
MENTAL HYGIENE, APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND
MENTAL HYGIENE;

(5) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
RESOURCES, APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY OF HUMAN RESOURCES;

(6) 2 PARENTS, ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE EMPLOYED OUTSIDE
THE HOME; AND

(7) A REPRESENTATIVE FROM EACH OF THE FOLLOWING:

(I) A PRIVATE DAY CARE CENTER;

(II) A NURSERY SCHOOL;

(III) A HEAD START PROGRAM;

(IV) A FAMILY DAY CARE PROVIDER;

(V) THE INFANT AND TODDLER PROGRAM;

(VI) A PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHER CERTIFICATED IN EARLY
CHILDHOOD EDUCATION;

(VII) A PUBLIC SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR WORKING IN EARLY
CHILDHOOD EDUCATION;
