expressed by the representatives of employee organizations.

- (g) The Advisory Council shall:
  - (1) Meet at least quarterly;
- (2) Submit an annual report to the Governor and, subject to Section 2-1312 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly:
  - (3) Maintain a record of transactions; and
  - (4) Maintain transcripts of meetings and proceedings.
- (h) The Department of Personnel shall provide administrative support to the Advisory Council.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
