fund the operating deficit of the Peabody Institute.

- (6) The Oversight Committee shall meet at least quarterly to review Peabody's progress and assure compliance with all State conditions. The Oversight Committee shall submit an annual report to the Governor and the General Assembly by January 1.
- (7) The funds specified in this appropriation shall be released only as the Oversight Committee certifies to the Board of Public Works that the above conditions are being satisfied.
